CALL FOR PAPERS

[The All-Russian Scientific Conference: “The Seas of Russia: Year of Science and Technology in the Russian Federation – United Nations Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development”](#) will be held in Marine Hydrophysical Institute of RAS in Sevastopol on 20–24 September, 2021.

The Conference is intended to support the strategic goal of the United Nations Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development – to create in-demand science in the interests of the ocean that we need and become one of the venues for the Year of Science and Technology in the Russian Federation.

The aim of the Conference is to improve the coordination of marine research programs, advance sea state monitoring systems, develop scientific potential, optimize planning of maritime space, and reduce maritime risks to improve management of resources in marine and coastal zones.

The Conference will be organized in the form of plenary, sectional and poster presentations in the following areas:

Section 1. Fundamental processes of the marine environment formation and evolution.

Section 2. Marine observing systems: methods, means and results.

Section 3. Rational use of marine environment resources.

The scope of Conference reports will cover the following issues:

- experimental and theoretical studies of hydrodynamic, thermohaline and biogeochemical processes;
- modern technologies and methods for calculating main oceanological parameters in seas and oceans;
- studies of climate change and anthropogenic impact on the marine environment state;

- modern and promising methods and means of contact and remote observations;
- mathematical modeling of ecosystem dynamics;
- economics and law in the field of navigation safety and use of marine resources;
- information and resource support of oceanological research and marine economic activities;
- methods and means of protecting the marine environment and providing rational use of natural resources;
- problems of the coastal zone of the sea.

The organizing committee reserves the right to determine the type of report presentation at the Conference: plenary, section or poster one, as well as their distribution by sections.

REGISTRATION

We invite specialists in oceanology, sea physics, ocean geography, biogeochemistry and environmental management to attend the Conference.

To register for the Conference, please fill out the [online registration form](#) and attach your report abstracts drawn up according to the requirements. After receiving the second informational letter with payment details, please send a copy of the payment receipt to the Organizing Committee email address: mhi-conference@mhi-ras.ru. You need to file a separate registration form for each report. In case of any difficulties with filling out the registration form, do not hesitate to contact the Organizing Committee at mhi-conference@mhi-ras.ru.

The registration fee is to be paid after receiving the second informational letter and amounts to 2000 rubles, for young scientists (aged up to 39 inclusive) – 500 rubles. The registration fee includes a set of working materials, a printed copy of the Conference proceedings, coffee breaks and a welcome dinner at the day of Conference.

Form of participation: **oral presentation, poster presentation, listener.**
Working languages: **Russian, English.**

Report abstracts will be published in the Conference proceedings (*with inclusion in the RSCI database*). The best reports will be recommended for publication as articles in the journals of Marine Hydrophysical Institute of the Russian Academy of Sciences: *Physical Oceanography* (Web of Science, Scopus), *Environmental Safety of the Coastal and Shelf Zones of Sea* (Higher Attestation Commission, RSCI).

PREPARATION OF REPORT ABSTRACTS

To publish report abstracts in the Conference proceedings it is necessary to attach the electronic version of the abstracts to the [online registration form](#).

The abstract file name should correspond to the surname of the first author in the list (e.g., JohnsonTD.doc). If the author has more than one abstract the abstract number is placed after the initials (e.g., JohnsonTD2.doc).

Page format: A5 (page size: 148 mm × 210 mm), portrait orientation.

Volume of abstracts: up to two pages of A5 format, Times New Roman 11 pt, single line spacing.

Margins: top, bottom, left, right – 20 mm.

Title of abstracts: font Times New Roman 11 pt, bold, no hyphenation, uppercase (capital) letters, center alignment, no indents.

The next line is empty.

Information about the author(s): full name (initials are given after the last name). If there are two or more authors they are separated by commas, the full name of the speaker should be underlined. Font Times New Roman 11 pt, bold, center alignment, no indents.

The next line is empty.

Information about the organization: full name of the institution, location (city, country). Font Times New Roman 11 pt, italics, no hyphenation, center alignment, no indents.

Email address for communication with the main author of the work. Font Times New Roman 11 pt, italics, no hyphenation, center alignment, no indents.

The next line is empty.

Keywords: the list of keywords begins with the text “**Keywords:**” (bold 11 pt) and can contain up to 10 words or short phrases separated by commas. Font Times New Roman 11 pt, straight, no hyphenation, justified alignment, no indents.

The next line is empty.

Text of abstracts: font Times New Roman 11 pt, single spacing, justified alignment. The indent of the first line of the paragraph is 5 mm. Do not provide tables, formulas, figures and the list of references in the abstract text.
